Joining Instructions



Check In

Please arrive at the airfield for an 09:00 check in .
Upon arrival report to the Check In tent marked with a black C on a yellow background.
Here you will be allocated your camp site and your Activities Group.
On checking in you will also need to have your Permission to Fly Form and your Camp Health Form – No forms = NO FLY !!!!

Kit

Attached is a recommended Kit List, please note that you do not need to bring plates and cutlery – these will be provided.

Catering

The camp will be fully catered with all meals and snacks provided. If you have any special dietary needs we must be made aware of these by **February 14th**. There are no shops on site – so no pocket money is required. You may of course bring your own sweets – sensible quantities only!

Electronic Items

iPods, MP3 players and phones may be brought to camp for use in camp only.
UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE THEY TO BE USED ON THE AIRFIELD as they represent a serious safety hazard. They will be confiscated immediately if seen.

Bad Weather

The camp will go ahead in the event of bad weather, if we are unable to fly on Saturday we have Sunday as a reserve. If the weather is un-flyable both days we have plenty of reserve activities.

Camp Close

Camp will close on Sunday 2nd April at 13:00hrs assuming all flying was completed on the Saturday.
