



Joining instructions

Flying takes place at the Cambridge Gliding Centre, (SG19 3EB) about 8 miles north of Royston. To confirm if the weather is suitable, please phone 07867973940 after 20:00 on the day before your flying. You can get some further information on Cambridge Gliding Centre from their website at www.camgliding.co.uk

A flying day starts on the airfield at 0900. When you arrive at the airfield in **full uniform**, please meet in the Car Park, where member of the Herts Scouts Air Activities team will meet you. The day will start with a safety briefing as soon after your arrival time as possible so please do not be late.

Finish time depends on a number of variables, the number of Scouts and adults to fly, how busy the airfield is, and not least, the pace of the Scouts themselves to get through the various activities. As a guide we will generally be finished by around 1600, but it may be later than this.

The balance of payment (£40 per head) will be invoiced on the day of flying and paid by BACS.

Catering at the centre is limited, so you are advised to bring a packed lunch - hot drinks and snacks are available. Airfields are exposed places, so you must dress appropriately for the season – warm clothes in the winter and sunscreen in the summer. MP3 / I-pod players are not permitted as these reduce the wearers hearing and pose a hazard.

We plan to fly a maximum of 10 Scouts or Explorers on the day. Anyone is welcome who is over 10 years old and under 100Kg, and can sign the medical declaration on the forms enclosed. Adults are welcome to fly if there is time at the end of the day.

Please ensure that everyone brings with them a signed permission form, without this you will not be allowed to fly. You do not need to inform the Information Centre that you are planning to fly with us, but should inform your local DC if they require this, and comply with the other requirements of PoR relating to Activities.
